RE: SPI purchase method for ECF fund orders

To Whom It May Concern:

We affirm our willingness to participate in the SPI invoicing method. If an applicant chooses SPI invoicing, Sonoran Integrations will accommodate this request for the Emergency Connectivity Fund (ECF), as long as the order for services and hardware is placed after the appropriate funding commitment decision letter for eligible equipment and services is received by the applicant and provided to Sonoran Integrations.

Applicants who select the SPI invoicing method will execute a Service Agreement with Sonoran Integrations. Applicant is responsible for all charges related to any ineligible equipment and services or services obtained, but not contained in the description of the service commitment request or decision.

Sonoran Integrations is not responsible for Applicants' compliance with FCC and USAC rules and regulations. Applicants who chose the SPI invoicing method should be aware that if ECF funding ends before the term of their services contract, they will be subject to the agreed rate of service for the remainder of the contract, net of any subsidy.
